



APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS – LEE COUNTY RED SOX SCHOLARSHIP **2018-2019**

PLEASE KEEP THIS COVER SHEET and use it as a checklist to be sure you send all required materials. Red Sox Foundation will be unable to process applications found to be incomplete as of December 31st, 2018. Please keep a copy of all application materials for your files.

- Applications must include all the following materials and must be submitted in one email by Monday, December 31, 2018 to FLScholarship@redsox.com.
- If possible, please send all materials as one document, labeled with your high school and name, i.e. *Cypress Lake High School, John Smith*. Please label each page with the page number.
- If you need to email materials in separate documents, please label each document with your high school, name and the material, i.e. *Cypress Lake High School, John Smith – Letter of Recommendation*, and send all materials in one email. Guidance Counselors may email transcripts and letters of recommendation separately.
- For materials you may have as a hardcopy, i.e. letters of recommendation, please scan and label them accordingly.
- If you need to fax the application, please fax them to the Red Sox Foundation, Attn.: Red Sox Lee County Scholarship at 617-226-6004 or mail them to The Red Sox Foundation at 4 Jersey Street, Boston, MA 02215 before the deadline.

Check list

- Completed application form.** Form can either be typed or handwritten and then scanned and emailed. The application form must include a list of **colleges you are applying to, or have been accepted to.**
- One written essay** – One essay of 500 to 1,000 words (max) - Please choose just ONE of the two essay questions on the application form. (The questions are similar to those on common college applications.)
- Personal Statement** – Please include a maximum 500 word personal statement telling us something about you that we would not know otherwise from this application.
- Student Aid Report (“SAR”)** – The SAR is the form sent back to you after you filled out the Department of Education's Free Application for Federal Student Aid (“FAFSA”). The SAR is required for any student applying for financial aid and helps colleges determine your student loans/grants/work study package. All applicants must include a copy of the entire SAR, including the Expected Family Contribution (“EFC”), with your application.– **If you have not received your SAR by this date, please include a copy of the confirmation email received upon submitting your FAFSA and send in your SAR as soon as it becomes available.**
- Official copies of high school transcripts** – Be sure that a list of your Grade 11 and 12 courses are included on your transcript. Please also include college transcripts if you have taken any college courses for credit while in high school.
- One written recommendation from your high school guidance counselor, employer, or a community service director** – NOTE: We understand teacher recommendations for college are a priority so a copy of a letter of recommendation is acceptable, however, your recommender should be aware of the academic talent and community service requirements of The Foundation for Lee County Public Schools scholarship. The counselor *does not need to write a special letter of recommendation* for the Red Sox Scholarships.
- Confirmation by May 1st of the college or university you plan to attend** – If you have been accepted and already know which school you will attend, please enter it on page 2 of the application form. If you have not heard back from the college(s) you applied to, please indicate that you are awaiting a decision on page 2 of the application form.

Lee County Red Sox Scholarship Committee will review applications and decisions will be made by the end of March. Applications must be emailed no later than Monday, December 31st, 2018 to FLScholarship@redsox.com
